Opening Hours

Woven Nursery is open:

Monday to Friday

8:30am – 4:00pm

50 weeks per year

Optional wraparound care:

4:00pm – 5:00pm

Year-Round Provision

Woven Nursery operates for 50 weeks of the year.

Children benefit from continuity of care, consistent routines and secure relationships throughout the year.

Government-funded childcare entitlements are therefore delivered using a stretched funding model across our operational year.

Woven Nursery offers limited term-time only positions.

The Woven Approach

At Woven Nursery, children learn through secure relationships, meaningful experiences and opportunities to explore the world around them.

All children receive learning opportunities planned in accordance with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

Our curriculum supports children to:

- Develop confidence and emotional wellbeing
- Build strong communication and language skills
- Explore nature and the world around them
- Develop creativity and imagination
- Become independent learners
- Build positive relationships with others

Every experience at Woven is designed to help children become confident, curious and capable learners.

What Every Child Receives

Every child attending Woven Nursery receives:

- High-quality childcare and early education
- Learning opportunities delivered in accordance with the EYFS
- Support from qualified practitioners
- Access to the nursery environment and learning resources
- Indoor and outdoor learning opportunities
- Individual support appropriate to their age and stage of development

These elements form part of Woven Nursery's core provision and are available regardless of funding arrangement.

Government-Funded Childcare

Woven Nursery welcomes families accessing:

- Working Parent Entitlement from 9 months
- Eligible 2-Year Funding
- Universal 15 Hours Funding
- Working Parent 30 Hours Funding

How our funded offer works

As Woven Nursery operates for 50 weeks each year, government-funded childcare is delivered using a stretched model in accordance with local authority requirements.

Universal 15-Hour Entitlement

Children accessing the Universal 15-Hour Entitlement are offered four afternoon sessions (1.00pm–4.00pm) each week. Woven Nursery claims only the child's annual funded entitlement of 570 hours. Any attendance provided above the funded entitlement is funded by Woven Nursery at no additional cost to families.

Working Parent 30-Hour Entitlement

Children eligible for the Working Parent 30-Hour Entitlement may attend Monday to Friday, 1.00pm–4.00pm, equating to 750 funded hours annually over our 50-week operating year. The remaining funded entitlement may be accessed with another provider through split funding arrangements or used towards additional sessions at Woven Nursery, subject to availability.

All funded places are subject to availability.

Families may access funded childcare without being required to purchase additional childcare hours or optional services.

Attendance Options

Families may choose from one of three attendance options.

Option 1 – Full Fee Nursery Place

Families attending on a fully private basis pay the nursery's standard daily fee.

Daily Fees

The daily fee includes:

- Childcare and early education
- Breakfast, lunch and snacks
- Nappies, wipes and basic consumables
- Forest School experiences
- Spanish sessions
- Yoga sessions
- PE sessions
- Cooking activities
- Community visits and outings
- Seasonal celebrations and events
- Creative and sensory resources

Most families choosing a full fee place attend a minimum of three days per week.

Option 2 – Funded-Only Sessions

Families may access their government-funded childcare entitlement without being required to purchase additional childcare hours or optional services.

Funded-only sessions are available:

Monday to Friday

1:00pm – 4:00pm

Universal 15-Hour Entitlement

Children accessing the Universal 15-Hour Entitlement are offered four afternoon sessions each week.

Woven Nursery claims only the child's annual funded entitlement of 570 hours from the local authority. The additional attendance provided above the funded entitlement is funded by Woven Nursery and is offered at no additional cost to families.

Attendance outside of a child's funded entitlement is optional and charged at the nursery's published rates unless funded hours remain available.

Working Parent 30-Hour Entitlement

Children eligible for the Working Parent 30-Hour Entitlement may attend Monday to Friday, 1:00pm–4:00pm.

This equates to 750 funded hours annually, with the remaining funded entitlement available through split funding arrangements with another provider or towards additional sessions at Woven Nursery, subject to availability.

Families accessing the funded-only option are accessing their child's government-funded early education entitlement. This provides high-quality early education delivered in accordance with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). As the funded-only offer does not include optional consumables or meals, families are responsible for providing any items their child requires during the session, including:

- Nappies (where required)
- Wipes (where required)
- Sun cream (where required)
- Food or refreshments (where required)

Option 3 – Nursery Place with Funded Hours + Enhanced Experience

Families may choose a standard nursery place and apply their government-funded childcare entitlement to the funded element of their child's attendance.

Eligible funded hours are allocated in accordance with the child's available government-funded entitlement.

Any childcare attended outside of the funded entitlement is charged at the nursery's published rates.

Families choosing this option may also choose to participate in the Woven Enhanced Nursery Experience.

Enhanced Nursery Experience

The Woven Enhanced Nursery Experience is entirely optional and includes additional meals, consumables and enrichment opportunities.

Enhanced Nursery Experience Fee

£27 per attended day

This covers:

All meals and snacks	£10.50
Consumables (including nappies, wipes, sun cream and other everyday care consumables used during the nursery day)	£2.50
Additional activities (including but not limited to SportyMinis, Forest School, Woven Cooking Club, Spanish classes, Music, HappyKids Yoga, local trips and walks)	£12.00
Learning Journal	£2.00

The experiences available may vary throughout the year.

Choosing not to participate in the Woven Enhanced Nursery Experience will not affect a child's access to their funded early education entitlement.

Children will continue to receive high-quality early education delivered in accordance with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) by qualified practitioners.

During optional enhanced activities, children accessing the funded-only option will participate in planned EYFS learning experiences appropriate to their age and stage of development.

Families may continue to access our funded-only sessions. Should additional attendance outside of the funded-only sessions be required, these may be booked at the nursery's published rates, subject to availability.

Participation in the Enhanced Nursery Experience is not a condition of accessing funded childcare.

Optional wraparound care is available:

4:00pm – 5:00pm

£13.75 per session

Parent Responsibilities

Parents are responsible for:

- Applying for funding within government deadlines
- Reconfirming eligibility where required
- Providing supporting documentation when requested
- Informing the nursery of changes affecting eligibility
- Adhering to nursery contracts and notice periods

Where funding eligibility changes or funding is no longer available, parents remain responsible for any fees due.

Important Information

Funding arrangements are subject to government legislation, local authority requirements and eligibility criteria.

Woven Nursery reserves the right to amend fees, funding arrangements and Enhanced Nursery Experience fees with reasonable notice.

Participation in the Enhanced Nursery Experience is entirely optional and is not a condition of accessing funded childcare.
